Competition Dates: Entries must be submitted between 1st October and 9th November.

Poem Entry: There is no entry form but all emailed entries should include the entrant's name. Entrants names will be redacted for the judging panel.

Poem Length: No more than 40 lines excluding the title.

Number of Entries: A maximum of three entries per person.

Age: All entrants must be 16 years or over.

Poem Format: All entries must be in English.

Entries: Should be emailed to positive imgesfest@yahoo.com as a word document or as a PDF.

Winner: £100 Runner Up: £60 Highly Commended: £30

Notification: All entries will be acknowledged and entrants will be invited to the Awards Ceremony. The Winner, Runner up and Highly Commended entrants will be announced at the Award Ceremony.

Awards Ceremony

This will take place at the Hope Centre, Sparkbrook Street, Hillfields Coventry CV1 5LB starting at 1.00pm Saturday 23rd November.

All entrants are expected to attend the event if at all possible.

All entrants attending will have the opportunity, if they so wish, to read one of their entries submitted to the Competition.

Publication of Poems

The winner, runner up and highly commended and best of the rest selected by the Judging Panel, will have their entries published in the Chatterbox Magazine and all entries will be published on the Positive Images Festival website www.positiveimagesfestival.co.uk

In addition, all the entries will feature in a Poetry Competition booklet which will be available in early 2019. All entrants to the Competition will be entitled to three copies of the booklet at no charge once the booklet has been published.
